



IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM THE SKC #2 January 2010

In this issue: LICENCING, TRANSPONDER PURCHASE, EMAIL ADDRESSES.

Welcome to Information circular #2 from the SKC. Periodically notices will be sent out to alert Karters to important information or issues that must be adhered to. It will be emailed directly to Karters who have supplied a current email address in the AKA Licencing System, and will also be published on Club websites and/or Noticeboards. This circular is being distributed with your 2010 AKA Manual.

Important Licencing Information:

1. you can only practice in what you are eligible to race in, penalties apply **Rule 13.20 (a)**
2. you can only use your race number in the class it is allocated to. If you change class, you might need a new number.
3. before renewing your licence your club membership **MUST** be current. **Rule 13.04.2**
4. Your licence **must** be renewed (completed) at least a week before a race meeting.
 - a. Licence renewals can take up to 7 days to finalise; therefore
 - b. Information required ie. Documentation, proof of payment, proof of current club membership must be received by the licencing officer **prior** to the licencing officer **commencing** to process your renewal;
 - c. It is imperative not to leave your renewal to the last week before a race meeting;
 - d. It is suggested that when your licence is due for renewal, that you apply for your renewal at least in the 2 week period prior to the race meeting you wish to compete at.
5. If paying by direct deposit, proof of payment **must** be sent before licence renewal can be commenced and finalised.
6. Email addresses are an essential component of the new licence system, please make sure we have a correct email address for you.*See below

Whilst it is understandable that not all Karters have an email address, it is imperative that if you **do** supply an email address that it will reach you. It is your responsibility to make sure it is correct and current. If you do have an email address and it is not in the AKA system, it would be helpful if you could include in your record please.

The SKC uses this medium to quickly notify and alert Karters to AKA rule changes, SKC decisions and other relevant information. Currently nearly 20% of emails are bouncing back which means Karters are not getting the information they need to compete legally and safely.



Transponder Purchase Information:

The State has received its first shipment of transponders that all karters will require as of 1 July 2010, or immediately if you are competing in major mainland meetings.

To purchase your transponder(s) you must either:

forward a cheque (along with postal address for delivery of your transponder(s)) payable to:

once you have direct deposited this amount you must send an email to Dale Madden at dandmmadden@aapt.net.au quoting your direct deposit details and your postal address for delivery of your transponder(s).

The cost to mail the transponder(s) will be met by the State.
