As the majority of you would be aware by now, a meeting was held amongst drivers participating in both the Leopard Light and Heavy classes at the Young Guns meeting of 1 February in Launceston. The reason for this meeting was prompted by declining numbers in these classes and the resultant lack of competition for the participants.

The drivers at this meeting, and proxies, overwhelmingly voted to run a pro-weight for the Leopard class of 167kgs, replacing Leopard Light and Heavy.

This 'decision' has not been formally presented to the SKC and Club Delegates but with only a week to the commencement of the Statewide Series there will not be this opportunity. As this appears to be the wish of the majority of drivers we are happy to implement it, effective from the first round of the Statewide Series.

The Rotax weights remain the same at 160kgs for Light and 180kgs for Heavy.
