Yamaha Vets Series – Information sheet

As part of our 50 years of karting celebration AKA Tasmania, with sponsorship from Yamaha Australia, are running a 3 round age-based Clubman Series.

This Series gives drivers in the 30 to 39, 40 to 49, and 50 and over age brackets the chance to race against other age disadvantaged drivers and share in some great prizes and trophies, thanks to Yamaha Australia.

The Series will host the following classes:

Clubman 30 to 39 Light & Heavy (140kg & 160kg)

Clubman 40 to 49 Light & Heavy (140kg & 160kg)

Clubman 50 to 150 Light & Heavy (140kg & 160kg)

Your age for the series is determined by your age on race day at NWKC (07/03/09).

The Series will be run using the Yamaha S (Clubman) motor only (Chapter 34).

All classes to be combined unless track capacity is exceeded, then classes will be separated according to weight.

All rounds will be run as 3 heats and a final.

All races in the Series will carry equal points towards the Series.

Points system per race: 25 20,18,16,14,12,10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1,0.

The Series will be run at the following Open meetings:

North Western Kart Club: 50 years of Karting Tas 7/8/9 March 2009

Southern Tasmanian Kart Club: Rising Stars 12 July 2009

Launceston Kart Club: Sportsman Feature 18 October 2009

Similar to the Statewide Series, trophies will be awarded according to an aggregated tally of entries from the 3 rounds, as below:

- 18 and above entries: 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 15 to 17 entries: 1st, 2nd
- Less than 15 entries: 1st

Series trophies will be awarded at the AKA State Dinner on Saturday 7th November.

Host clubs will award trophies on the day based on normal entry numbers.

Win a Yamaha S Clubman Engine

At the conclusion of this Series **TWO** new Yamaha S engines will be raffled between the Series participants. .

Drivers will automatically be entered in a draw on the following basis.

- Compete at one round: one ticket
- Compete at two rounds: two tickets
- Compete at all three rounds : four tickets

Raffle is open to Tasmanian licensed drivers only.

Raffle drawn at the AKA State Dinner. Winners will be notified.
