<b>7.2.</b>	If insufficient entries are received for a Class and/or Division to form in its own right, the <b>Compulsory Competition Classes will be Consolidated in accordance with Competition Rules - Chapter 1, Rule 9.</b> Discretionary Competition Classes may be Consolidated in accordance with the Rules or Cancelled at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.		
<b>7.3.</b>	If a Class or Division is cancelled, the Entry Fee may be refunded at the discretion of the Organiser and in accordance with the Rules.		

### 3. SPECIFIC COVID-19 RESTRICTION AND MITIGATION REQUIREMENTS

<b>COVIDSafe ACTION PLAN</b>	
The Club has completed a COVIDSafe Action Plan and submitted it to the relevant State Government Department. All actions identified as being required to be done to create a COVIDSafe Event and Club facility must be carried out prior to and during the Event.	
<b>1.</b>	<b>PERMITTED AND NON-PERMITTED PERSONS</b>
<b>1.1.</b>	<b>No person who has symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (this includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, lack of smell or fatigue) is permitted to attend the Circuit or participate in the Event.</b>
<b>1.2.</b>	<b>Any person who starts to feel unwell or to exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 during the Event must immediately avoid contact with all persons at the Circuit and MUST IMMEDIATELY LEAVE the Circuit.</b>
<b>2.</b>	<b>SOCIAL DISTANCING AND DENSITY REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>2.1.</b>	Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons are not permitted to gather in groups greater than 100 while in attendance at the Event.
<b>2.2.</b>	Government prescribed Social Distancing measures must always be observed.
<b>2.3.</b>	The use by Permitted Persons of any indoor facilities is strictly limited by the Density Quotient of the room as included in the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan.
<b>2.4.</b>	Food service provided at the Event must fully comply with all State Public Health Authority Orders/Directions/Regulations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hand Hygiene must be available at all food service outlets.</li> <li>Regular cleaning in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan MUST be carried out throughout the Event.</li> </ul>
<b>3.</b>	<b>CHECK IN REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>3.1.</b>	<b>All Attendees MUST complete the compulsory State Government issued QR Code Check-In or use the contact tracing record sheets that are provided upon arrival at the Circuit if required by the State or Federal Government.</b>
<b>4.</b>	<b>HYGIENE FACILITIES - TOILET/WASHROOM FACILITIES and HAND SANITISER</b>
<b>4.1.</b>	The Club is required to provide facilities to ensure general and sensible hygiene practices are maintained.
<b>4.2.</b>	Toilet and washroom facilities at the Circuit must be open and available for use.
<b>4.3.</b>	Washroom facilities must be properly equipped with liquid soap, running water and either air hand driers or paper towels. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The toilets and washroom facilities must be cleaned at least once during the day or as otherwise required in accordance with the Club's COVIDSafe Action Plan</li> </ul>
<b>4.4.</b>	It is strongly recommended that Essential Karting Personnel and Permitted Persons bring their own supply of hand sanitiser for use in accordance with government recommendations in addition to hand sanitiser that is supplied by the Club.

		<b>The order of Karts on the grid for the commencement of Qualifying must be random - no high/low numbers)</b>
<b>4.</b>	<b>Heats &amp; Final</b>	The system of gridding will be in accordance with State Regulations - <b>Series</b> Competition Format 2 <b>Race 13</b> - Results of Qualifying, fastest to the front. <b>Race 14</b> - Results of Qualifying, fastest to the front. <b>Race 15</b> - Points from finishing positions of Race 13 & Race 14 (highest points to the front). <b>Race 16</b> - Points from finishing positions of Race 13, Race 14 & Race 15 (highest points to the front).

		<b>Winner</b> - The Round Winner will be the Competitor with the highest overall points from Races 13, 14, 15 & 16, and not first over the line in the final Race. In the event of a tie-on points, placings will then revert to the Competitor with the Fastest Qualifying Time.

<b>3.</b>	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>
<b>3.1.</b>	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Practice, Qualifying and Racing.
<b>3.2.</b>	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
<b>3.3.</b>	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a <b>HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST</b> on the upper torso.
<b>3.4.</b>	Karts can be retrieved via the Out-Grid gate <b>ONLY</b> .
<b>4.</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
<b>4.1.</b>	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
<b>4.2.</b>	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
<b>4.3.</b>	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.
<b>4.4.</b>	No motorised scooters, minibikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
<b>4.5.</b>	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.

<b>1.2.</b>	All Classes/Divisions from the Commencement of Qualifying, each Competitor is permitted to use a Maximum of one (1) set of Dry Weather Tyres for two (2) Rounds of the Series in accordance with the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Round 1 &amp; Round 2 - One (1) set of Dry Weather Tyres</li> <li>• Round 3 &amp; Round 4 - One (1) set of Dry Weather Tyres</li> </ul>
<b>1.3.</b>	Wet Weather Tyre requirements are in accordance with the respective Class Rules.
